Activity Corner

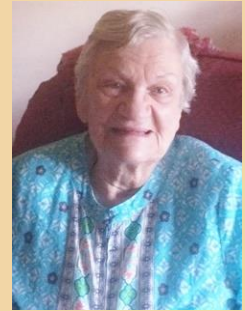
Hello November! Here are a few programs we are offering in November besides the regular scheduled music programs offered monthly,
